

## **APPLICATION FOR AN EMERGENCY TRAVEL CERTIFICATE**

(for person under the age of 16)

**VALID FOR ONE SINGLE JOURNEY TO SOUTH AFRICA**

The following documents need to be submitted in order to have an Emergency Travel Certificate (issued for a maximum period of nine (9) months from date of issue issued:

- Two (2) passport size photographs as per specifications
- Duly completed [BI-73](#) Application for new SA passport
- € 11,00 (Euro eleven) application fee (in cash or bank transfer – see details below for the SA Embassy Vienna)
- Copy of present passport
- Copy of marriage certificate of parents
- Motivation for ETC (see last page of application form)
- A copy of the flight ticket or flight confirmation needs to be submitted as the details must be entered on the document
- The South African residential address must also be provided
- If passport has been lost/stolen a Police Report regarding the loss passport must be submitted

Carefully read page 3 of the passport form before completing the application.

You have to submit the application in person at the South African Embassy in Vienna for the taking and certification of the fingerprints and photos. Furthermore both parents have to be present when the document is being applied for. The processing time is approximately 5 – 10 working days.
