

VISA REQUIREMENTS FOR SLOVENIAN PASSPORT NATIONALS

Slovenian passport holders are not exempted from visas and should apply for a visa before leaving for South Africa.

In order to apply for a visitor's visa, passports must be valid for at least 30 days after leaving the RSA (§2(3) Immigration Act, Act 13 of 2002) and should furthermore contain at least three unused pages (§2(1)(d) Immigration Regulations of Immigration Act, Act 13 of 2002) for the endorsement at Passport control.

When applying for a visa, a person should also be in possession of a valid return flight ticket, proof of accommodation and proof of financial means, which shall be in the form of a recently issued bank statement, which should cover the last three (3) months.
